Major sections focus on NPP/VIIRS DNB processing; inter-calibration between NPP/VIIRS and DMSP/OLS; applications associated with socio-economic activities, applications in monitoring urbanization; and fishing activity monitoring. The chapters in this book were originally published as a special issue of the International Journal of Remote Sensing.
